1.	Richelieu Blanc, Vin de Pays du Gers - France A blend of Colombard and Ugni blanc giving aromatic, tropical and citrus fruit characters with an appealing clean fruit-driven style and a crisp floral finish.	£13.95
2.	Sauvignon Blanc, Finca El Picdor - Chile This wine is made from 100% Sauvignon grapes, fermented at a low controlled temperature to maintain the typical fresh cut grass aromas and ripe gooseberry characteristics on the palate.	£14.95
3.	Pinot Grigio Ca'Solare - Piedmont, Italy Piedmont is located in the north west of Italy and these higher altitude vineyards, with their long ripening period, produce wines of deep flavour and fine balance. This Pinot Grigio is no exception - a lovely wine with notes of almonds and spice on the finish.	£17.50
4.	Picpoul de Pinet, Le Jade - Côtes du Thau, France Fresh, crisp, dry style wine, gently scented with pleasant citrus fruit flavours, a lovely balanced wine great.	£19.95
5.	Sauvignon Blanc, Kuki - Marlborough, New Zealand An explosive array of passion fruit and gooseberry aromas combine with a smattering of crushed herbs. A classic Marlborough palate of lime, currants and ripe guava fruit supported by a razor sharp minerality.	£21.95
6.	Sancerre, Domaine Sylvain Bailly - Loire, France Immense, forward fruit, delicate equilibrium and a zippy finish to boot.	£27.95

7.	Calancuni Grillo, Agroagento, Villa Sandi - Sicily This Sicilian wine comes from the eastern shores of the island which benefits from the cooling Mediterranean breezes. The palate is soft with intense aromas of tropical and citrus fruits but refreshing zippy acidity.	£17.95
8.	'Pitch Fork' Unwooded Chardonnay - McLaren Vale, Australia Ripe peach and melon aromas with butterscotch overtones. The rich creamy palate finishes with soft lingering flavours and firm acidity.	£18.50
9.	Chenin Blanc, Avondale Estate - Paar, South Africa The palate is dense with ripe peach flavours and a good intensity of tangy freshness.	£19.95
10.	Loriñon Blanco, Bodegas Bretón - Rioja, Spain Citrus, toasty and floral aromas, with a good balance between fruit and wood.	£22.50
11.	Saint Veran, 'Vers Le Mont', Roger Luquet - Burgundy, France Crisp, lemony fruit, pure flavours of green fruits and quenching acidity.	£24.95
12.	Chablis, Domaine Testut - Burgundy, France A beautiful full flavoured wine, elegant and classy with a lingering finish on the palate.	£26.95

14.	Viognier, L' Aristocrate - Vin de Pays d'Oc, France The nose expresses perfectly the broad repertoire of all fantastic flavours of the Viognier, such as peach, apricot, almond aromas. The smooth and velvety palate, reinforces the beautiful feeling revealed by the nose.	£17.95
15.	Riesling Paulett - Clare Valley, South East Australia Deliciously zippy and aromatic with stunning Riesling typicity.	£22.95
16.	Torrontes, Crios de Susana Balbo - Cafayate, Argentina The Northern wine producing region of Cafayate produces the finest Torrontes in Argentina - delicious juicy peaches and white blossom.	£23.95
17.	Sauvignon Gris 'Kadun' Vina Leyda - Leyda Valley, Chile Very pale, clean nettle/straw colour. Aromas of lime, spice and white flowers. The palate is very clean, very crisp with a tropical edge to the fruit, finishing with a twist of sherbet.	£24.95
18.	Gewürztraminer Haegelin - Alsace, France Luscious, pure lychee and geranium fruit, perfectly balanced by a taut acidity.	£26.50

20.	Corail, Château de Roquefort - Côtes de Provence, France Since returning to the family domaine in 1995, Raimond has followed biodynamic/organic principles and produces delicious hedonistic wines. The Corail is simply "heartwarmingly beautiful".	£23.95

21.	Richelieu Rouge - Vin de Pays d'Oc, France This blend of Grenache and Carignan has been topped up with 20% ripe, plummy Merlot to give an extra richness.	£13.95
22.	Pinot Noir, Jean Didier - Vin de Pays d'Oc, France Light cherry fruit gives way to a soft earthy finish.	£16.95
23.	Chianti Leonardo - Tuscany, Italy A bouquet full of concentration and fruit intensity. Red berries and spicy overtones are complemented by lovely soft, ripe tannins.	£21.95
24.	Fleurie, Domaine de Gry Sablon - Beaujolais, France An elegant, velvety wine that is full of raspberry and cherry flavours. Superb gamay.	£26.50
25.	Pinot Noir Fox, John Belsham - Marlborough, New Zealand This very aromatic and approachable wine exhibits red and black fruits underpinned with sweet spices and forest floor nuances.	£27.95

26.	Merlot, Finca El Picador - Chile 100% Merlot grapes grown in non-grafted vineyards. Medium bodied, with lovely sweet plum fruit and a mellow, soothing finish.	£14.95
27.	Zinfandel, Angels Flight - California, USA A Medium bodied vibrant Zinfandel with aromas of black berries and gingerbread. The full ripe fruit flavours are well balanced with structured tannins and leave a hint of spice on the finish.	£16.95
28.	Primitivo di Puglia, A.Mano - Italy Stunning. Deep colour, a ripe brambly palate with an almost Shiraz-like character.	£19.95
29.	Château Gasquerie, Côtes de Castillon - Bordeaux, France Deep purple, a bouquet of black fruits with toasted coffee notes, ripe and round cassis flavours and warm finish.	£21.95
30.	Rioja Vega Crianza, Bodegas Muerza - Spain A very velvety wine on the palate with a great structure and fruity expression. Six months ageing in oak has given greater depth and flavour to the wine.	£22.50
31.	Cabernet Sauvignon 'Bellotto' Vina Leyda - Leyda Valley, Chile Subtle notes of oak, perfectly integrated with the fruit. Medium body with a great concentration of flavours, with a bright acidity and velvety tannins.	£24.95
32.	Chorey-les-Beaune, Machard de Gramont - Burgundy, France The vines enjoy a superb aspect, which produce beautifully consistent fruit year on year. Fermented and aged in 30% new oak.	£27.50

33.	'Pitch Fork' Shiraz - McLaren Vale, Australia Lifted aromatics of spice and red fruits, strong mid palate with typical varietal characteristics.	£18.50
34.	Carmenere Reserva, Tonada - Chile A fruity black cherry bouquet with overtones of coffee. Aged in 100% French oak for 14 months, the palate is laden with ripe, chocolaty fruits with finely textured tannins.	£19.95
35.	Pigeolet des Brunier - Vin de Pays de Vaucluse, France A blend of 80% Grenache and 20% Cinsault and Syrah with a hatful of Cabernet Sauvignon. A great wine this vintage - rich and succulent with the added influence of spices and herbs.	£21.50
36.	The Ruins 'Organic' Pinotage, Bon Cap Estate - Eilandia, South Africa Perfumed red currant fruit combined with a classy earthy South African tang. This wine is guaranteed to surprise you as we feel it over delivers.	£22.95
37.	Merlot Cabernet Franc, Irvine Wines - Eden Valley, Australia The Cabernet Franc adds characteristic violet floral overtones and structure to the softness and rich plum characters of the Merlot. Both varieties blended add complexity and harmony on the palate to this very interesting wine.	£28.50

41.	Pol Roger White Foil NV, Epernay An appealing and complex nose of delicate white flowers and brioche, with a fresh and lively palate showing good balance. Creamy texture and great depth.	£47.50
42.	Bollinger Special Cuvée NV, Aÿ “Bolly” is well known for it’s masculine black grape cepage (70% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay is the norm). A high percentage of mature wines in the blend gives this famous Grande Marque immense flavour.	£54.95
43.	Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé NV, Tours-sur-Marne Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens up to provide a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries.	£64.95
44.	Dom Perignon 2000, Epernay Elegant in style with undertones of almond on the palate with a gloriously long finish.	£135.00
45.	Pol Roger Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill 1998, Epernay Deep old gold hue and its infinitely fine and sparkling bubbles make this Champagne special. The nose brings dried fruit and strongly scented flowers, a rich palate.	£140.00
